Ice machine observed clean and well maintained. The facility sells pre-packaged food and drink items, with some pre-made foods that are heated before selling.

All hot foods observed at or above 135F (taquitos measured 136F)

All refrigeration units measured below 41F. Thermometers were attached and operating. All cold foods in the reach-in and walk-in observed well organized.

Restrooms were fully stocked with soap, paper towels and hot running water.

Restrooms were observed well maintained.

All hand washing stations were observed fully stocked with soap, paper towels and hot running water.

The ice machine was observed clean and the scoop was noted outside the machine, and in a manner that would avoid cross contamination.

Facility is clean and maintained.
