### **Overall Inspection Comment:**

Facility inspection conducted and the following is observed;

There is no hot holding or kitchen prep area.

This facility sells only prepackaged food items. All food items are displayed and stored at least 6 inches above the ground. Ballon inflation tank is mounted and secured.

All refrigeration units measure below 41F and have operational lighting. No expired or adultered foods observed. Clean the interiors of the refrigration units to avoid buildups from spillages or damaged goods.

No cans were noted on shelf with denting. No bloated cans noted. Check shelves regularly for dented cans.

Baby food and formulas are observed within sell by dates.

Restrooms are observed in clean condition with soap, warm water, and paper towels.

Damaged food items are clearly separated from the food to be sold.

No evidence of pest or vermin infestation is observed. Pest control conducted on a quarterly basis. Follow pest control report instructions for best practices regarding best practices in regards to pest control and elimination.
